



REPORT ON DISPERSAL SALE TUESDAY 11 MAY 2010

A large crowd gathered at the dispersal sale of livestock and equipment on behalf of Mr & Mrs AG Briscoe & Son at Hall Farm, Harpole. Buyers were in attendance from as far afield as Ireland, Scotland, Yorkshire and the West Country, together with our loyal sale followers. We started with 130 lots of miscellaneous tools and sundries which included 30 tonne of feed barley selling for £2,010. Other small lots chainsaw £85, PTO shafts £85, 10 new galvanised sheep hurdles £180, feed barrows to £85, footbath £68, electric fence units £75, cattle barriers £138, mill and mix machine £200, a near new Bateman cattle crush £1,270, 100 round bales wheat straw £440, calf creep feeder £280. Then off into the yard for a collection of well maintained arable and grassland equipment; trailed chain harrows £200, Vicon RSM Rotaflow fertiliser spinner £740, 2003 Vicon DMP 2401 mower £3,600, 2001 Lely RP220 round baler £8,100, Votex topper £500, 49 round bales silage £400, Dowdeswell DP7 4 furrow reversible plough £1,650, Dowdeswell PH300 power harrow £2,800, Quivogne APXE TL discs £4,400, AS Marston 8 tonne grain trailers made £2,000 and £2,800, similar 10 tonne trailers £2,900-£4,000. The Claas Dominator 98S combine made £13,600, 1999 Daihatsu Fourtrack £1,350, Edlington hydraulic rolls £3,000, tipping trailer £560, 10ft Ifor Williams livestock trailer £2,250, Manitou 628 telehandler on a T plate with 5500 hours £16,200, buckets, muck forks and bale spikes £180-£420. To finish the machinery the tractors a 1972 Leyland 253 2wd made £780, Massey 390 with loader P plate 2772 hours £10,700, John Deere 6400 4wd 1995 with 5770 hours £14,400 and Massey Ferguson 4270 on a X plate 3308 hours £15,550. Then to the livestock, a mixture of cows and calves and stores met a flying trade. The cows and calves averaged £1,142. Leading prices 3 year old Charolais cow with Devon bull calf £1,420, 3 year old Charolais cow with Devon heifer £1,300. The Hereford cows mainly 6 years old made £1,200 to £1,400 per outfit. An Angus cow with Devon bull calf, back in calf, £1,520. One single in calf cow £720. 6 year old Devon stock bull £1,550. 2 heifers with heifer calves at foot £1,150 an outfit. Then on to the stores being prodigy of the many cows sold. 14 month Charolais steers £760, 2 good bunches of yearling Charolais steers £655 and £710, Devon steers £600. Heifers met a good trade, all yearlings Charolais £585-£590, Devon heifers and the odd Charolais from £450 to £580 ranging from 13-20 months. A pleasing days trade right through.
