REPORT FOR THURSDAY 4TH JULY

667 Sheep forward saw a much better trade than expected in comparison to many centres around the country. Prices are similar to what happens every year, trade at this time of year takes a drop.

Lamb prices topped at £156 or 325p to average all in 292.6p, even with an increase in numbers by 250%. Ewes sold to £141 to average £106.70 which also saw an increase in entries by 44%.

Please contact Jake for price predictions and to ensure you enter your stock with him so that he can inform the buyers. Take a note of what the market requires, maybe marketing lambs as stores rather than finished, it may save the time and cost of fattening, as there is plenty of good demand for stores.

Standard Weight Lambs - Selling to 282p for 38kg lambs from E Dee; A Hodson sold 37.5kg lambs to 280p or £105; E Sansom & Son sold 37kg lambs to 278p or £103; and Fine Seasons sold 39kg lambs to £107 or 274p.

Medium Weight Lambs - Prices reached 316p at 43kg for George Thompson Farms and WF Knight & Son, or £139 for 45kg from Raveley Fen Farms; JR Smith & Son sold their 40.5kg lambs to 311p; W Hammond sold 44kg lambs to £138 and RJ Lee sold 45kg lambs to £138.

Heavy Weight Lambs - Top price of the day sold to 325p or £156 for 48kg lambs from George Thompson Farms; £155 for 51kg lambs from KS Lee; Raveley Fen Farms sold 49kg lambs to £151, JR Smith & Son sold 48kg lambs to £147; £145.50 for 48kg lambs from Giles Green; £145.50 for 47.5kg lambs from RJ Lee; and £144 for 47.5kg from RJ & WR Crosse.


