Fur & Feather Report – Saturday 4th September

1213 LOTS FORWARD

Once again another jam packed week, with every pen in the shed full to capacity. The day started with the sale of 105 lots of **sundries** at 9.30am, with all manner of entries seeing dog crates to £10, tools at £5 and sawdust at £4. Highlight of the morning saw a live export crate reach £20. **Caged birds** saw one of the best showings forward with Love Birds selling to £40, Diamond Doves to £24, Budgies to £25, Zebra Finches flashed to £22. Sale of the day saw a massive £90 for a Parakeet. **Hatching eggs** kicked off with a specialist entry seeing 27 trays of turkey eggs reach £3.50. Guinea Fowl eggs made £5.20 and Legbar eggs sold to £2.20. **Boxed poultry** saw a smart showing with hen and chicks selling to £26, with more boxes of chicks and quail selling consistently to £10. In the **Fur** section Rabbits and Guinea pigs continue to grow sale on sale with over 90 entries penned on the day. Pigs in sow consistently sold to £15 with Dutch Steel doe rabbits fetching £24. With a showing of fantastic variation throughout all the **Poultry** pens, top of the day saw Call duck trios to £35 a bird and Pekin hens made £12 a bird; Olde English Game trios topped at £15 per bird, Silver pheasant pairs came to £17 per bird. The turkeys and geese topped with African geese to £17 per bird with turkey stags to £17.
