REPORT FOR THURSDAY 20TH OCTOBER

755 Prime Lambs

Trade wasn't dampened by the weather, and Thursday saw a mixed showing of lambs forward. Finished lambs sold to top end prices with leaner store lambs punished with price. On the whole a smart trade with JC & JS Helliwell topping to 249p/kg with their 43kg Beltex cross lambs, with following pens to £108 for 44kgs and £107.50 for 45kgs with their 50kgs lambs flying to £118; A Pearson & Son topped the day overall with a thumping show of Charollais cross lambs seeing the weight pay with 58.5kg lambs topping to £127.50, with followers at 52.5kgs to £122. SQQ levelled to 226.45p/kg.

Highlights - RS Whatton & Son drew the goods with smart Texel lambs topping to £125 for 60kgs; RA Bounds drew the goods with a sterling run of best finished lambs reaching £124 for 54kgs with following pens to £123 and £121; JB Elkington topped their run with a thumping show of best finished heavier weight lambs, seeing their Texel crosses sell to £123 for 52.5kgs and £119 for two pens of 51.5kgs and 52kgs, following pens saw £117.50 for 50kgs; T Samson penned a best showing of meated Beltex lambs with 51kgs selling to £118; lighter lambs of the day topped with AK Wilson and their Rouge lambs selling to £108 for 45.5kgs.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 22ND OCTOBER

Store Cattle

A strong showing of cattle forward this week with all grades forward. Charles Hopperton topped the day with big framed 23 month old Charolais steers topping to £1345, with followers to £1275 and £1255; JP Watts drew the usual class of best end Limousin steers at 18-22 months reaching £1135, with south Devons at 19 months topping to £1125; RA Bounds saw the highest of the native breeds with well fleshed Hereford steers at 19 months top to £1080; DTA Tomkins drew some of the youngest cattle with big framed 11 month old Limousin steers flying to £1010; JTG & PA Harris saw a run of south Devons of smart frames with 15 month old steers topping to £1000 and heifers at £910.

Store & Breeding Sheep

Breeding Sheep - the day started with big framed Easycare theaves from Pytchley Farms selling to £78; M Kellet had their usual stamp of pure Texels forward with top conformation Texel ewe lambs selling to £118, with the same stamp of ram lambs seeing £103; CA Freeman had a smart Beltex shearling ram selling to £132.

Store Lambs - all grades forward with best end lambs selling to fierce buying power, longer term lambs harder placed with limited buyers, trade looking stressed week on week, numbers should be brought forward as soon as possible. CA Freeman topped the day to £98 with best end Texel lambs with Beltex to £86; FW Smith & Son topped the Suffolks for the day with big frame lambs reaching £84; A Maskell drew a smart run of Charollais crosses forward with short term lambs selling to £78; NP & MJ Russell topped their run with Texels to £75. Longer term types seen sub £60.

Feeding Ewes - smaller numbers forward this week with Greenfield Farm selling Jacob ewes to £38.

Calves

WJ Robinson topped the day with a sterling run of TB4 British Blue bull calves at a month old selling to £300 with followers at £280 and £240, the same vendor saw their heifers top to £285 and to £245 and £240; D Player penned a run of 6-7 month old reared calves with Aberdeen Angus bull calves reaching £115, Jersey crosses to £105, with Aberdeen Angus heifers of the same age topping at £135.

A smarter showing of all weaners forward this week. N Gabriel topped the day with Landrace crosses at £27; B Cranwell saw a well bred run of Large White weaners at £20 over the entire run; Fineseasons penned a young run of Welsh weaners at £4.
