Trade easing nationally again this week with the SQQ at 332.13p/kg. Best shape lambs are continuing at premiums with Ellsbury seeing highs of 358p/kg for 42kg best end Texels; J Bourne & Son topped the day overall at £155.25 for 45kg Continental crosses with P & M Careless seeing the same highs for Charollais at the same weight. H Taylor saw their best end Texels at 42kgs to 355p/kg. Good meat smart lambs were seen over 345p/kg with over 47kgs harder sold at around 315p/kg.
