REPORT FOR SATURDAY 25TH MAY

Store & Breeding Cattle

R Cave saw a well meated Lincoln Red cow forward at 7 years old and Farm Assured selling to £1505, setting the pace for the day with a 9 year old Limousin cross cow with a 2 week old Limousin heifer calf at foot selling to £1200.

C Stancombe & Son drew a serious run of quality with British Blue steers at 15 months old selling to £1450 in forward condition with equally as smart and younger types to £1410, Their 15 month old Limousin steers topped to £1300.

Store & Breeding Sheep

Numbers short in all sections with more needed on the trade.

Ewes & Lambs - Woodview Farm started the day with a flyer seeing full mouth Texels and strong 4 week old ram lambs selling to £145 a life, with their full mouth Charollais ewes and single ewe lambs selling to £140 a life; O Garnham penned a strong show of poll Dorset flock age ewes with singles at foot selling to £94 a life; R Martin saw a younger entry with cross bred ewe lambs and Continental lambs selling to £90 a life.

Store Lambs - a small seasonal entry forward with T Nursall selling Continental lambs with strong frames to £117 with followers at £84; Maydencroft Farm Partnership saw Hebridean ram lambs to £62.

Feeding Ewes - best ewes drove the trade with W Aves & Son topping to £141.50 for better shape meat with big thick ewes to £134, leaner meat types topped to £130; O Garnham saw a strong trade with Texel crosses of good lean meat to £137. Native bred types saw meat Jacob ewes to £61.

Calves

A strong trade ringside with full confidence on the day. JEG James topped the day with a best end show of British Blue bulls at 26 days old selling to £445 with their heifers of the same stamp to £320, their Angus bull calves sold on a flyer with the best to £250 and heifers to £180; FH Pullin & Sons saw 2 weeks old Holstein Friesians to £40.



Anglian Water - Fens Reservoir

Anglian Water, working in partnership with Cambridge Water, is proposing a new reservoir in the Fens.

The proposed site is between Chatteris and March, near to Doddington, Wimblington and Manea. During times of high rainfall, river flows from the Great Ouse catchment would feed the reservoir with water which will then be treated and transported to supply homes and businesses.

Anglian Water are engaging with local landowners, homeowners, communities and other stakeholders as they develop their proposal. The Phase Two Consultation will start on 30th May 2024 and is an opportunity for people to have their say on the developing proposals.


