We knew of 50 Store Lambs prior to Tuesday and 150 turned up and when we contacted potential buyers presale many didn't want to come to buy stores because of the lack of entries, this then reduces the competition around the pens. Unfortunately we don't know what you are thinking and we are here to help you get the best prices on the day. Please don't just hope for the best.

Lambs forward today were made up of 75% of lambs weighing under 45kg, not what the current market is looking for unfortunately. But many lambs were better sold in the finished section in comparison to the store section.

60 Standards – Quite a number are being bought as store lambs for further finishing in this section. Prices topped at 230p for two Beltex lambs weighing 36kg from E & N Noble; 35.5kg Texels from A Summers sold to 221p; Walters Partnership sold 35kg lambs to 207.5p; WE Budd & Son sold 36.5kg lambs to 206p; Cotswold Stud & Farms sold their 36.5kg lambs to 205p; WW Steele sold 37.5kg Easycare lambs to 186p; and RE Greenhill sold a 34kg lamb to 180p.
