225 Prime Lambs

Trade held steadier on the week with new buyers in the alleys. SQQ 280.12p/kg. TO Withers topped the day pence per kilo with best end Charollais lambs at 40kgs selling to 300p/kg. C Lockton topped the day overall at £143 for big framed meat 55kg Dorset crosses. Lighter lambs saw the biggest lift in trade with more demand all round.

Highlights - John Bourne & Son saw best end Texel crosses to 290p/kg for 41kgs with P & M Careless hitting the same heights for Texel and Charollais crosses at the same weight; Baylis Farming saw their Texel crosses top to 288p/kg for 41.5kgs; AV Taylor saw the best of the Suffolk trade with 46kgs to 265p/kg.

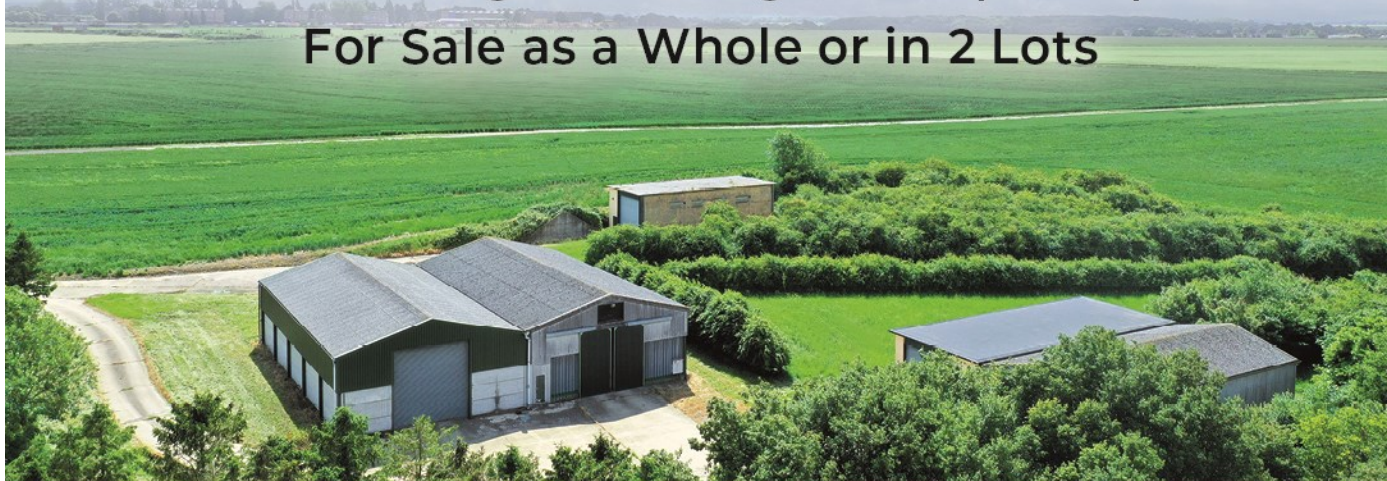
