### **REPORT FOR SATURDAY 24TH JUNE**

#### Store & Breeding Cattle

An entry of twenty Cows with Calves at foot sold to £1580 twice for 10 year old Simmental cows with a month old Hereford bull calf at foot from M Turner, who averaged £1393 per outfit; JA & PJ Wright entered two Hereford cows 10-13 years old with Limousin calves at foot selling to £1400 from £1260; JR Squires entered twelve cows with calves at foot which sold to £1490 to average £1189 per outfit; WBK Smith & Son entered an 11 year old Hereford cow that had run with the bull which sold to £910 and a 10 month Simmental steer which sold to £770.

Fred Wootton sold a 10 month British Blue heifer to £745 and a 12 month Aberdeen Angus heifer to £675; R Martin sold two 21-23 month Limousin heifers to £970, 13 month Aberdeen Angus heifers to £755; 10-13 month Angus heifers to £705, a 13 month Hereford heifer to £620 and a 26 month Blue steer to £770.; DJ Evans sold a 24 month Lincoln Red bull to £840 and 11-18 month Lincoln Red steers to £800 from £720; J Howkins & Son entered nine steers 26-28 months which sold to £1665 to average £1535 and a 33 month Angus steer which sold to £920; J & D Bavington sold three Aberdeen Angus heifers 1-4 months to £390 from £150; TG Williams entered six Limousin heifers 13-16 months which sold to £900 from £840 to average £863.

#### FARM CRISIS NETWORK bTB RESEARCH & SURVEY

The results of the survey will help FCN to better understand how farmers and farm families perceive the threat of bTB, helping us to support those at risk or affected by a bTB breakdown.




