REPORT FOR TUESDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER

A full yard in this week with every pen full! Over 1000 Prime and Store Lambs penned alongside the Culls.

728 Prime Lambs

Trade looks to have eased on the week with lighter lambs still harder to place. Best conformation/export and heavy lambs (44kgs+) found high demand with all buyers. SQQ 223.54p/kg, down on the week but there appears to be a national decrease. J & M Ironmonger topped the day with a sterling run of show spec Texel lambs seeing their 53kgs sell to 251p/kg with the biggest of the day from the same vendor at 66kgs sell to £151.80.

Highlights - A North & Sons saw equal highs with their usual top spec Texels at 46kgs selling to 250p/kg; W Stock & Son saw notable highs with smart Charollais at 54kgs topping to 233.5p/kg; MJ Gillet & Partners drew a tremendous run of Charollais lambs seeing 48.5kgs and 48kgs sell to 230p and 231p/kg; NJ Foster saw the usual best finished Texels forward with 46kgs topping to 230p/kg; W Painter penned a smart run of well finished lambs with their smarter end topping to 233p/kg for Charollais at 40kgs; C Clews drew a well bred run of Texels at 45.5kgs reaching 230p/kg. The lighter lambs of the day topped to 229p/kg from S Walby with 39kg Texels.

TR Tame & Son topped the day with a big framed run of Suffolk lambs flying to £91, with following Continentals at £78; CJ & L Vernon Miller topped the day with the smartest lambs seeing compact best shape Beltex lambs sell to £86.50; EJ Farmer saw a well bred run of Charollais to £80. Bright mid frame lambs looked comfortable in the mid £70's, with the longer term lambs looking far dearer at £60 plus.

Big framed thick ewes continue to demand the trade with active accounts ringside drawing numbers and top end trade. Dancer Brothers topped the day with the best example of a Charollais ewe forward in recent weeks selling to £164.50, a show stopping price for a show stopping ewe, the same vendor saw other Charollais to £133 and Mules to £109; TR Tame & Son topped the rams for the day with a smart Texel selling to £135; C Ridgway & Son saw a younger less stylish cross bred ram reach £130 looking better sold on the day; Lambs End Ltd topped the Suffolks for the day with powerful stretchy ewes topping at £128; JK Coldicott topped the Mules for the day with two big framed thick ewes reaching £115.
