Ewes & Lambs - the change in the weather has brought full force in the alleys this week with a fantastic sale. Older ewes with young lambs were seen around £80 a life.

Store Lambs - another strong sale with numbers drying up now, MD Contracting topped with Norfolk Horns to £141 with followers to £107; Sutton & Son saw smart Charollais to £125; R Rickard penned Texel Mules with a high of £121 and ram lambs to £120. Every lamb sold was £100 plus.


