REPORT FOR SATURDAY 24TH SEPTEMBER

Store Cattle

An entry of 90, which started with the sale of some Cull Cows which sold to £1210 with others at £1100, £1075 from £1000 for 4 Simmental Cows aged 5 to 17 years old from T & JH Scrimshaw.

Plenty of buyers keen for cattle this week. Steers topped at £1120 for a bunch of 18 month old Charolais with others very keenly sought after. Heifers sold to £1100 for a 16 month old Luing, and 16 month old Charolais heifers sold to £1015.
