362 Prime Lambs

Prices eased on the week with Mondays Bank Holiday causing a lull. SQQ 230p/kg. Trends continue with weight and meat finding premiums, lean lambs of all weights saw hard penalties applied. Penny & Annie Bonner topped two sections this week with their storming Texel lambs selling to 258p/kg and £136 over different pens.

Highlights – lighter lambs topped the week for NC & S Sheppard & Son with their Suffolk cross lambs at 45.5kgs selling to £110; JR Smith & Son top end prices for their Texels, with lambs at 44.5kgs selling to £105; The weight continues to pay with SC Wells topping their run at £121 for their usual top quality Texels at 48kgs; C Stancombe & Son saw some of the best trade on the day with 47.5kgs Texel Mules selling to £120; SJB Luckett & Son topped their run with their heaviest Continentals seeing 56kgs selling to £130.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 27TH AUGUST

Store & Breeding Cattle

Five **Cows & Calves** on offer this week saw prices top at £1500 for a 10 year old Limousin cow with a month old Charolais calf at foot and £1280 for an 8 year old Hereford with a month old Charolais calf at foot; FH Pullin & Sons Ltd sold two Aberdeen Angus heifers with 3 month calves at foot to £1000; and J & D Bavington sold a Simmental heifer with a 3 month Simmental heifer calf at foot to £940. **Steers** sold to £1215 for two 16 month Limousin steers and **Heifers** sold to £1050. FH Pullin & Sons Ltd entered twenty-six Holstein Friesian steers aged 3-6 months which sold to £320 to average nearly £250, three 9 month Angus heifers sold to £430; and from J & D Bavington a 5 month Hereford heifer sold to £460 and two Angus heifers sold to £435.

Buyers are concerned there could be a lack of numbers to purchase in the Autumn months, if you have some cattle, we definitely have the buyers. Please let us know of your entries, so that we can inform the buyers.

Calves

An entry of thirty-three calves forward this week sold to £290 for British Blue heifers from JEG James, their Blue bulls sold to £280 and an Aberdeen Angus bull sold to £280, others of their younger Angus calves sold to £250 from £190; AG Burton saw their entry top at £250 for Angus bull calves from £150, their Angus heifers sold to £200 from £160 and their Holstein Friesian bulls sold to £45 from £38; FH Pullin & Sons entered Friesian bull calves which sold to £90 from £45.

Goats

British Alpine Goatlings sold to £85 from £70 and their kid sold to £50 for RP Webb; and two Golden Guernsey wether kids sold to £50 for J Rule.

282 Store & Breeding Sheep

Rain in the east draws the crowd and the trade. All in average saw £64.91, down on paper for the week but far dearer in the pens. A far more level penning this week overall. Longest term lambs were bought in the £60's with bigger frame mid term well into the £70's. KA Titmus topped the day with Suffolk ram lambs to £148 with Charollais to £130; Cambridge University Farm saw short term Texel crosses at £108.50; E Marchington saw the trade of the day with Gritstone ram lambs topping at £80.50; I Sargent penned a bright run of Continental crosses with frame selling to £79; L Price topped with their Beltex Texel run at £77. **Feeding Ewes** - extreme variations on the day with ewes averaging £85.73. E Goss topped with Texel crosses to £146; and KA Titmus saw £138. FE Harris & Sons topped the draw with aged Charollais rams to £120; G Smith saw the trade of the day with their slight Charollais ewes to £115.




