REPORT FOR THURSDAY 21ST JULY

944 Prime Lambs

The biggest example of a two tier trade to date, finished lambs over 43kgs held a strong trade with anything under 43kgs or lean heavily penalised and at a low store trade. This end of week sale reflected the forthcoming weeks predictions in trade following abattoirs announcing a 50 pence drop in deadweight prices. Prices on the day saw the SQQ back 24 pence, averaging 261.7p/kg. Top of the day saw DA Chapman take the pence per kg selling Continental lambs at 52kgs to 298p; R Spencer had an absolute flyer with a sterling show of Texel lambs, the heaviest saw 64.5kgs sell to £169 with 53.5kgs at £153 and 45.5kg to £130.

RJ & WR Crosse saw equal highs with smart Continentals at 43.5kgs selling to £123.50; J & K Holmes penned the usual goods with their top end Texels at 45kgs to £123.50; Isaac James saw some of the best prices with his best end Charollais at 42kgs selling to £120 or 293p/kg. Weight continues to pay seeing JI Holmes topping at £141 for 50.5kg Continental crosses; RC & JT Bailey saw similar highs with their Suffolk crosses at 49.5kg to £139; SGC Hill also penned a run of Suffolk crosses with 58.5kgs selling to £140 and 48kgs to £131.

Store & Breeding Cattle

An entry of two empty **cows** sold saw prices to £1590 for a 5 year old Charolais cow, weighing approximately 750kg and a 4 year old Angus cow weighing approximately 500kg selling to £850.

Cows & Calves sold to £1560 for a 10 year old Blonde cow with a month old Limousin calf at foot with three other similar lots selling from £1300 to average £1452.

Store Cattle sold to £1160 for a 25 month Simmental heifer from RD Holland and three Limousin heifers 17-21 months sold to £1050; R Munns entered steers which sold to £1010 for a 20 month Aberdeen Angus and a bunch of 19-24 month Herefords sold to £900.

Pigs

Topped at £90 for an entry of six from Letchworth Garden City to average £85; C Tomline sold 10 week old weaned pigs to £20; DJ Frost entered a mixed pen of colourful weaned pigs which sold to £18 with other smaller types from £4 to £8 each. One sow forward this week from HM & NJ How sold to £32.

M Wilkinson topped the day with powerful Texels to £150 with followers at £119; Letchworth Garden City saw a tremendous run of Charollais and Charollais crosses forward with the best end topping to £116, the following trade saw five lots sell to £90 and above with the vast majority at £80; S Goodship saw a similar trade with a smart showing of big framed Charollais selling to £105; JM Grace continues to draw the goods with Texel lambs selling to £79. 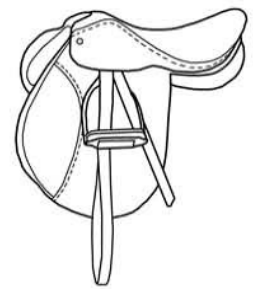
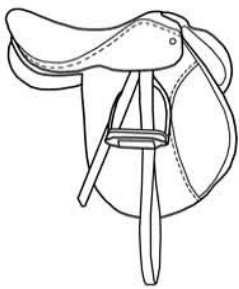
