REPORT FOR THURSDAY 8TH DECEMBER

587 Prime Lambs

A better entry this week with a good showing of meat forward. Prices have no doubt slipped on the week nationally, but meat and conformation continue to realise premiums. SQQ 241.33p/kg. Market prices are hard to compare in recent weeks with the Christmas Shows in full swing, but best end prices were seen at Thrapston with CJ White topping at £145 for 59kg Texel crosses with both frame and meat; JH Jones & Son topped the day with 279p/kg for 40.5kg best meat Continentals.

Highlights – C Stancombe & Son continue to draw a quality showing of meat with fed Texel Mule lambs topping to £112 for 45kgs, with the same stamp of heavy lambs at 51.5kgs reaching £127; John Gowling & Son had another top showing of Charollais crosses all best meat with 44kgs at £111, with 48kgs to £120.50; Scott & Scott penned a top notch run of Texel lambs with 52kgs topping to £130; G & J Rattray saw their usual goods top to premiums with 59.5kgs Charollais crosses to £140.

DM Walsh topped to £126 for a best end Texel ram; Wager Farming Partnership penned a quality showing of thick Suffolk crosses with the leanest peaking to £119; KS Lee drew big framed crossed bred teaser rams topping to £117; AJ Cony & Partners topped the Suffolks for the day with ewes topping to £114; TW Lane saw the best of the Mule ewe trade with ewes reaching £93. Smaller frame meat ewes continue to sell well all above £85 with the leaner sorts at £70 plus. Feeding ewes still around £50.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 10TH DECEMBER

Store & Breeding Cattle

Prices topped at £1340 for a 13 month Blue steer from BW Costin & Sons, who also entered a 17 month Limousin heifer which sold for £970; next top realised £1060 for an 18 month Charolais heifer from TG Williams with others to £1010 and a Limousin yearling heifer sold to £990; Mrs D Daglish sold 21 month British Friesian steers to £1025 and a 43 month Friesian heifer sold to £850; AH Farming entered four 10-13 month Limousin steers which sold to £885; D Blunt sold 9-10 month South Devon steers to £550; M & M Hutton sold 5-8 month Limousin steers to £650 and 7 month heifers to £700 from £410 and two other heifers 24 & 29 months at £435; M Finch sold a 7 month Hereford bull to £300; Mrs D Morris sold 9-11 month Sussex, Holstein and Angus heifers to £225, 7-9 month Herefords to £180 and her 7-9 month Simmental & Hereford steers sold to £215.

Calves

A good entry of calves saw prices reach £290 for a British Blue bull calf from WJ Robinson with others at £280 and £260, his Blue heifer calves sold to £220 and his Angus bull to £225. Other entries from AG Burton sold to £115 for Angus bulls, £75 for Angus heifers and £50 for Holstein Friesian bulls.

Pigs

Saddleback weaned gilt pigs sold to £60 for GM Wade and their Saddleback sow sold to £10. S Brain sold a Gloucester Old Spot sow to £35 and a boar to £26

Goats

One goat forward, a Boer x Nanny sold to £90 for S Brain.

270 Store & Breeding Sheep

Store lambs saw a quality penning with shorter term lambs in forward condition driving the trade, longer term lambs saw a bright and healthy entry with a comparable stronger trade on the day. All in average £69.14. E Sansom & Son topped the day with Charollais Mule lambs of big frame selling to £97.5; WG Childs & Sons penned their usual stamp of quality with best bred Texel lambs reaching £96.50 and £92; JF Fountain & Son drew an extensive run of smart lambs with Continentals selling to £90 and followers to £88, £88, £86, £80, £77.50 and £70.50; D Evans topped their run with Ryland crosses to £87.50 with Herdwick ram lambs at £73.50; NP & MJ Russell saw their Beltex lambs to £81 with Continentals at £72 and £61; D Jerrams draw another respectable run of Continental cross lambs to £66 with the rest in the £60's.

Feeding ewes saw a larger entry than recently with fifty-three averaging £50.38. J Pringle topped the day to a massive £190 for a Dutch Spotted ram; A Pittom topped the ewes with Texels to £118, with followers at £97 and mid £70's; C Lewis penned a tidy showing of Kerry ewes reaching £100. Smaller framed, part meat ewes were seen at £50 plus with the leanest types at £40 plus.
