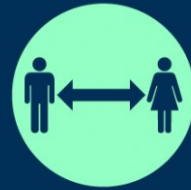

Plants, Produce & Miscellaneous

Two weeks back on track and sales have doubled! All sections seeing fantastic entries with plenty more to come. Next week we plan to hold a fur and feather section again pending the approval of a new licence, we will keep all updated on the Facebook page on the Monday. As for this week's sale, highs were seen with 236 lots in the **plants section**, with hanging baskets to £7, cucumber plants to £2, potted tubs to £4, fuchsias to £5 and pots of petunias to £1.70. 180 lots forward in the **sundries section** with the national collection centre for lawn mowers really starting to thrive, Hayter mowers sold to £80 with Husqvarna leaf blowers to £76. A stationary Lister engine sold to £50 and dog run panels to £46, sale of the day saw a man & dog water fountain sail to £40. 80 lots of **hatching eggs** drew the crowds with half dozen turkey eggs selling to £5.20, 15 guinea fowl eggs at £4.50, and an average for hen egg trays at £2.20. **Produce** saw a quality entry with more needed week on week, bags of bread topped at £5, asparagus to £3.20, leeks to £1. Boxes of mixed vegetables sold to £6.
