A proper penning of lambs forward this week with best end quality in the mix as well. Weight is in demand with over 43kgs seeing a clear hike in trade. Lighter lambs are harder sold unless they're export quality. SQQ 336.54p/kg. JA & P Dickinson topped the day with their 44kg Texels at 366p/kg and topping overall at £180 for 50kg Texels of the same stamp.

Highlights - Cartwright Farms saw their best end stamp of Charollais lambs forward with 45.5kgs selling to £162; DJ & AL Underwood topped their lambs at £161 for best meat Texel crosses at 45kgs; WF Knight & Son saw a continuation of best end Continental lambs forward with 45kgs to £154 and 43kgs to £152 twice; WP Groome saw a tremendous show of Texels seeing their 50kgs lambs to £177; R Swinfen & Sons topped their run of weighted lambs at £165 for 47kgs; R & M Arrowsmith saw Suffolk and Texel crosses at 47.5kgs to £164.50; JI & JA Claypole saw their Cheviot Mule cross Texels top at £162 for 47kgs.
