## REPORT FOR WEDNESDAY 14TH SEPTEMBER

### **Breeding Sheep**

A far more buoyant sale ringside at the second Breeding Sale for Thrapston, with buyers finding confidence and giving a decent trade. The day started with **Ewe Lambs** topping at £108 from WG Childs & Sons with their Texel crosses and further pens to £105; CN Sansom penned a smart showing of Texel Lambs with best conformation selling to £105. The **Theaves** and **Ewes** drew the crowds with Suffolk theaves selling to £150 from Conington Farms Ltd over several pens; SF & JH Wagstaff saw the same top end prices for their theaves; ME & TE Broome topped with their Scotch Half Bred x Suffolks to £168, with their usual run of top end power seeing a total of six pens sell to the same mark; John Gowling & Sons topped the Texels with their powerful and stretchy theaves selling to £165; Giles Green penned a smart run of best bred Texel and Continental crosses with smart conformation reaching £150; the top end of the Mules saw a sterling run from J McGrath with his theaves selling to £160 over several pens and £158 for a following four pens; Conington Farms Ltd drew the same class of theaves with their entire run selling to £150. The dispersal sale of J & K Holmes packed a real punch with the top end of their Texel run selling to £150 for 6 tooth ewes and a majority run in the late £140's.

### **Rams**

## **REPORT FOR SATURDAY 17TH SEPTEMBER**

### **Store & Breeding Cattle**

A Devon cow with a calf at foot from HB Paynter sold to £1400; an empty plain Charolais cow from JP Parkinson sold to £290 and his 39 month Charolais steers sold to £910 from £700.

Top price in the Store Cattle section sold to £1250 for a pair of 17 month Limousin steers, 14 month Welsh Black steers sold to £1045. Younger sorts from D Player sold to £660 for an 11 month Limousin, 9 month Angus sold to £600 and younger Continentals sold to £550. Heifers sold to £1290 for a 17 month Limousin with others at £870 for a 29 month Limousin heifer and £780 for two Charolais at 27 month; HB Paynter sold four over-age Devon heifers with too much condition (H grades +) that went over the scales weighing 525–640kg, which sold to £1203.20 from £892.50. ### **Store & Breeding Sheep**

Trade a little steadier this week, with a shortage of short keep lambs along with the grass having stopped growing again due to the lack of rain. Even though store lambs prices topped at £105 for S Mack and £96 for FW Smith & Son; S Mack sold a pen of Continental lambs to £94; RA Ford sold lambs to £91; J Woodbridge & M Wallis sold Suffolks to £87; M & M Hutton sold lambs to £86, along with EM Sherwin & Sons at the same price; J & K Holmes sold Texels to £82; and ATC Lepper sold his entry to £79.

Quality is easy sold, second quality seems to be harder to place at premium prices. Theaves sold to £140 from £100 for Texels from M & M Hutton; Jacobs sold to £100 for MJ Woodbridge & M Wallis.

Breeding Ewes sold to £120 for entries from M Wright; JSW Handy sold ewes to £95 for Jacob x ewes and £91 for others; MK Jones sold Lleyn ewes to £86 from £74.

Still plenty of demand for Feeding and Cull Ewes which sold to £120 from £92 for TP Hinch; smaller sorts sold to £87 from EM Sherwin & Sons; and £79 for A Thorpe.
