REPORT FOR THURSDAY 14TH JULY

1079 Prime Lambs

A fantastic draw on the week with the biggest penning of the season. Highlights of the day saw J & K Holmes top with their Texel lambs at 313p/kg and WH Tanner & Son topping in the lump at £148. SQQ 286.37p/kg. On the day, best end lambs sold to absolute premiums with some of the best runs of quality seen to date. Once again weight continues to hit high demand., light lean lambs were very hard sold on the day. Recent weather and lambs altering with age have caused a big influx in under finished lambs forward, prices reflected the finished condition of the lambs on the day.

WF Knight & Son continue to draw the best end lambs with their Texel/Beltex crosses topping to £137.50 for 44kgs and £139 for 46.5kgs; HD & PJ Cranfield drew a sterling run of quality on the day seeing one-hundred and forty-four in the pens, their best end Beltex lambs saw premiums with 44kgs selling to £135; D & AE Allen & Sons followed suit with a sterling draw of best finished Masham cross lambs with a top draw of two-hundred and twenty-six in the pens, their best pens saw 44.5kgs reach £135; J & K Holmes continued the run of class with their Texels at 43kgs selling to £134.50; WH Tanner & Son topped the weight and price for the day with Border Leicester crosses at 53.5kgs selling to £148; Reynolds Farmers Ltd penned the best of the Suffolk lambs on the day seeing 50kg lambs top to £145, with 49kgs selling to the same price; Lloyd & Walton drew a top end draw of well finished lambs with their Continentals at 50kgs selling to £142.50; Upton Mill Farm saw some of the best trade on the day with their 48kgs Suffolk Texels selling to £139 at 48kgs.

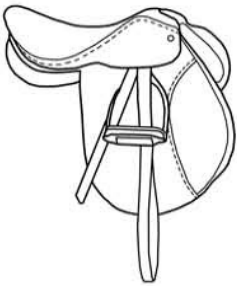

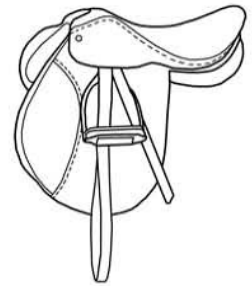
