REPORT FOR TUESDAY 4TH OCTOBER

Another good entry this week. Whilst not as busy as last week, over 720 forward. Prices topped at £124.12 or 242p, Cull Ewes sold to £151 and Store Lambs sold to £75.50. Best demand is for the heavier lambs, but lighter, well finished lambs are selling to more of a premium than they did last month.

A difficult choice is being made in the sorting race between store and finished lambs. Some very lean lambs have been put in the fat section due to their weight, and have been realising more in this section than the store lambs, but obviously selling well below the pence per kilo average.
