REPORT FOR THURSDAY 29TH SEPTEMBER

627 Prime Lambs

A varied entry forward this week with 44kg plus lambs far outperforming lighter sorts. Weight continues to pay with some premiums for smarter export types. SQQ 225p/kg. Trade dropped slightly on the week nationally, with export trade limited with strikes in France. WF Knight & Sons topped the day with smart Continental lambs at 47kgs selling to 246p/kg or £115.50 with other pens at 50kgs reaching £118. WG Childs & Sons topped the day overall with a thumping showing of Charollais and Texel crosses selling to £137 for 60kgs lambs, and the following pens saw £125 for 54kgs and 62kgs.

Yelden Growers Ltd saw a top end trade for their best meat Texel Mule lambs with 50kgs selling to £118; George Thompson Farms Ltd penned a tremendous run of Charollais x Continental lambs with fourteen pens topping to £117 for 50.5kgs; DO Threadgold saw a strong top end for equal class of Texel lambs with the best finished 49kgs selling to £117 and 69kg of the same quality to £135; JC & JS Helliwell flew to the top with Texels at 51kgs topping to £117; JD & JA Miles & Sons topped the Suffolks for the day with a thick pen of 55kgs selling to £124.50.

Store Cattle

A smart showing of cattle forward this week with all grades forward and buyers looking to have peaked interest. R Martin showed first with a tidy entry of well grown Aberdeen Angus and British Blue heifers topping to £810 for 27 months old and 15 months old seeing £770. RG Percival had a sterling run of Charollais and Limousin steers forward seeing the best top to £1400 for three with followers at £1390. Charles Hopperton saw their Charollais heifers through the ring at around 20 months old selling to £1160. Eastern Farms Ltd drew a run of matching Aberdeen Angus steers and heifers all around 20 months old topping to £1195 for the steers and £990 for the heifers. D Player saw the younger entries of the day with a comparable dearer trade, seeing an entry of all heifers from 7 to 11 months old. 11 month old Limousins topped to £510 with Aberdeen Angus at 7 to 10 months old flying to £545.

269 Store Sheep

Store lambs – another longer term entry forward this week with trade looking to have eased once more. All in average for the week saw £58.37. PR Wilderspin topped with Texel ram lambs to £90 with followers at £80. MK Jones Livestock saw a smart run of Continental lambs with the biggest frames selling to £80 and £75. AJ Geary penned a smart run of Cheviot cross lambs topping to £70 with larger frame Charollais crosses to £72.50. NP & MJ Russell topped their run of Texel lambs with a smart showing of conformation reaching £70. Longer term lambs recently seen in the £60's are now selling in the £50's. **Feeding ewes**, a varied entry forward once again with all fields covered. Ewes averaged to £68. MK Jones Livestock topped the day with smart Blue Texel and Suffolk crosses selling to £104. S Yates topped with their Jacob ewes selling to £95. J&V Short topped their run with Texel ewes reaching £94, with Texel rams to £91.50.

A tremendous run of calves forward this week with WJ Robinson topping to £370 for British Blue bull calves, with followers to £360, with their heifers topping to the comparable levels at £300 and two to £280.
