REPORT FOR THURSDAY 5TH OCTOBER

550 Prime Lambs

Trade held steady again this week with an SQQ at 245.25p/kg. Best end lambs are continuing to fetch premiums for both meat and weight. Store lambs would be better sold on a Saturday. L Blackman & Sons topped the day with a tremendous run of Beltex and Charollais, seeing lambs top to 273p/kg for 41.5kgs with their 44kgs to £112. PM Bonner topped the day overall with an unmatched show of Texels to £160 for 68kgs and £137 for 57kgs.

Highlights - George Thompson Farms saw a smart run of Continental lambs forward, with their 50kgs selling to £133 and 45kgs to £115 for several pens of the same stamp; MHF Ltd saw a smart best end show of Texels with their heavy 48kgs selling to £140; AK Wilson saw some of the best trade on the day with Texel cross lambs selling to £145 for 59kgs, their 50.5kgs to £130 and their 49.5kgs to £129; JI Holmes saw the same trade with best end Texels at 49kgs to £130.

Store & Breeding Cattle

Cows & Calves – The entry was made up of a Dispersal from Arthur Adams, his Charolais cows with Aberdeen Angus calves at foot sold to £2750 from £2550, Aberdeen Angus cows with Angus calves at foot sold to £1850 and his older 10-13 year old Hereford cows with calves at foot sold to £1560, to average £1820. His Aberdeen Angus stock bull sold to £1620.

Store Cattle – **Steers** sold to £1490 for Charles Hopperton with a 19 month Angus steer, with others to £1320; RG Percival sold his 19 month Angus steers to £1435 and a Lincoln Red to £1240; a bunch of 21 month Hereford steers from I Walpole sold to £1030. **Heifers** sold to £1050 for an 18 month Hereford; JTG & PA Harris sold three 16 month South Devon heifers to £880 and 12 month heifers to £660; AR Adams sold an 8 month Angus heifer to £680; and R Booth sold a 22 month Hereford to £600. **Bulls** sold to £650 for two 11 month Herefords from C Harrell.

Calves

Two weaned calves sold to £340 for a 7 month Hereford bull and £310 for a 6 month British Friesian; WJ Robinson sold 4 week old British Blue bulls to £270 from £255, a Holstein Friesian bull to £50 and his heifers to £260 from £250; JEG James sold British Blue bulls to £250 and heifers to £260, their Aberdeen Angus heifers sold to £150.

Pigs

Sold to £70 for NED the black boar from T Bateley and their other white weaned pigs sold to £60 and £55. Weaned Berkshire pigs from C Cardell sold to £30 from £25; J Welsby sold Micro Pigs to £50 from £5.

Another fantastic trade this week with all sections looking a stronger trade, buyers were in abundance with more sheep needed to fill orders.

Breeding Sheep - Rawnie Elliot topped the day with Dutch Spotted shearling rams to £250, with their grade 4 Dutch Spotted ewe lambs topping to £140; I Benton saw a sterling trade for Llanwenog theaves topping to £127 with shearling rams at £210; J Macdonald saw a smart show of compact Suffolk theaves selling to £170; C Banks sold a best shape Texel ram at £160.

Store Lambs - power sold to a best end trade with the longest term lambs looking the dearest on the day. An all in average saw £71.33. A Walker topped the day with Valais Black Nose wether lambs to £130; Peter Groome saw the best entry forward with tremendous length and shape Texel lambs selling to £130, £109 and £98; P Childs topped their run with part meat Continentals at £91; M Grange saw a well grown run of Texel Easycares with a high of £89 following at £84. The vast majority were seen in the high £70's with long term lambs at £65 to £70. Soay ram lambs sold for £6.

Feeding Ewes - a trade unmatched nationwide with ewes averaging £69.33. W Bishop topped with Continental crosses to £120, with Mule ewes to £95; FW Smith & Son topped the Texels on the day at £118 for smart meat ewes; K Toone saw the best end trade with Jacob ewes to £110; P & J Green topped the rams with Herdwicks to £90. Any ewes of frame or meat were seen in the £70's with native breeds around £60 to £65. The very longest term were still £45 plus.

Smallholders Sale

Another very busy Saturday Smallholders sale with a large number of entries once again. We started with the **Sundries** with prices reaching £110 for a tamper, five calf coats sold to £55 with a bright pink double dog show pen achieving £50. A plastic rabbit hutch made £50 and an old Wicksteed cast horse galloped to £45. Dog cages topped at £40 and calf pen fronts to £40. Produce followed with boxes of apples to £6, pumpkins to £2.50 from £1 and rhubarb at £2. Onto the Hatching Eggs, with a slightly larger entry than previous months prices topped at £6 for ½ dozen Mille Fleur Pekins, Black Silkies and Frizzled Pekins to name but a few. Both Guinea Fowl and Quail eggs sold to £1 for a dozen. Further down the table Ferrets, both Jills and Hobs on offer met a fierce trade with Hobs to £40 from £8 and the Jills to £35 from £10. A very large entry of Caged Birds this month also met a strong trade, a Cockatiel sold to £40, Canaries to £39, a single Goldfinch Mule to £38 and Budgies to £30. Zebra Finches reached a high of £25 from £3. **Farm Kittens** once again were well received, though slightly back on previous months selling to £55 from £5. Down the line and onto the **Pigeons**, with an increased entry not looking quite so well sold, but nevertheless Show Racers topped at £9 a head, with Fantails, Racers and Tumblers reaching £2 a head. Guinea Pigs next, and a seasonal smaller entry saw a Sow with young top at £42, In-Pig Sows sold to £20 with individual Sows reaching £16 from £3. Boars sold to £4 from £1. Finally the **Rabbits** and what an end to the day, Belgium Hares were strongly fought over with a mated Doe selling for £80, a single Doe to £70 and a Buck to £40. A Netherland Doe with young sold to £65. Plenty to suit all pockets with both Bucks and Does starting at £2. Next sale Saturday 4th November, please remember to book your cages!


