Store & Breeding Cattle

Feeding Cows – A good entry of feeding and near finished cows were entered, selling to £1610 for a cow from JC & JS Helliwell; J Kimbell saw £1200 for his entry; and M & M Hutton sold their 12 year old Bazadaise cow to £1010.

Cows & Calves – J & D Bavington sold a Simmental heifer with a 2 month Simmental heifer calf to £1200.

Store Cattle – TG Williams entered some strong steers and heifers to top at £1520; D Daglish sold three 18 month Friesian steers to £1100; S Garley sold a Hereford heifer 19 months to £1000; CG Holt sold six 14 month Angus heifers to £850, £810 from £690 and his Steers sold to £760 and £700; JF Fountain & Son sold ten pure bred Charolais steers and heifers to £685; R & S Anderson sold a 25 month Simmental steer to £1010; J & D Bavington sold a 24 month Limousin steer to £900; and PR Rogers sold two Red Poll steers 20-21 months to £700 from £630.

Exempt Feeding Cows – (Are able to go home, to an exempt feeding unit or to slaughter without a pre movement test).

Three cows from J Kimbell entered today, not TB tested sold to £1200 for a Saler cow, £1100 for a 13 year old Hereford and £930 for a 11 year old Simmental, just proving that it doesn't make a lot of difference tested or un-tested with the right buyers around.

Bulls - from TEW Farming sold to £1115 for a 14 month Limousin; and M & M Hutton sold a 17 month Angus to £1010.

Calves

J & S Bardwell sold two 4 month Angus heifers to £360; and JEG James saw his calves top at £260 for British Blue bulls and their Simmental heifer also sold to £260.

Goats

An entry of aged dairy goats from Redlands Farm Enterprises sold to £120 from £90; and an entry of Nannies with Kids at foot from J & S Bardwell sold to £95 per life.

Pigs

Fine Seasons sold twenty one white weaned pigs, which topped at £30 from £18.

Store Lambs saw an influx in numbers this week with a strong trade throughout. All-in average for the day at £87.13. R Martin topped with Charollais to £109; with D Player penning a strong run of 100 Texel crosses, with the top four pens to £90 and followers at £89.

Ewes with Lambs - a showing of class forward, with the biggest run of hoggs and lambs to date. K Buckby penned a run of top end Blue Texels with double theaves and ewe lambs at foot selling to £152 a life or £456 an outfit; FC Lester & Son topped the hogg trade with Mules and Suffolk lambs selling to £113 a life; with SF & JH Wagstaff penning Suffolk mule hoggs and Continental lambs at £99 a life; S & C Hopcraft saw another smart run of Texel Mule hoggs and Beltex lambs to £94 a life over several pens; CD Hughes topped the older ewes with flock age Suffolk crosses to £84 a life.

Feeding Ewes saw a bumper trade this week averaging £101. RJ Garley topped the Suffolks for the day at £140 with followers at £130; C Hughes penned a smart showing of Charollais with the top end to £130; S Gawthroup saw Continental crosses to £115.
