REPORT FOR THURSDAY 23RD NOVEMBER

622 Prime Lambs

A mixed entry forward but quality meated lambs saw a clear premium. All export types and heavies were in demand, store lambs are better sold at Saturday Store Sales. SQQ 255.89p/kg. Guilford & Sons topped the day pence per kilo with best end Beltex crosses at 40.5kgs selling to 291p/kg. CJ White topped the day overall with 54kg Texel crosses to £146 with 52kgs at £139 and 50kgs to £140.

Highlights - SJ Hubbard saw 44kg Beltex crosses to £123 for their usual stamp of best finished lambs; Grange Farm topped with Continentals at 44.5kgs to £122 for best meat; Corney & Sons continue to draw a quality run of Charollais with their 51.5kgs topping to £136; WH Tanner & Son drew a load of heavies with Suffolks to £144 for 56kgs for two pens and 53kgs to the same money.

Trade looks to have stayed the same overall with feeding ewes easing slightly. Averaging £80.19 PA Wilford topped the day with big framed Continentals at £120; WH Tanner & Son saw the best of the Suffolks with smart meat ewes to £116, and topping the Mules for the day at £90; BJ Soul saw the trade of the day with lean meat Texel crosses at £111. All meat ewes were over £80, with lean healthy sorts at £70 plus, true feeders were sub £50.

SHEEP VENDORS

New Veterinary Attestation rule for farmers to be introduced on 13th December 2023.

Action Needed Now.....

What's changing?

Changes in legislation, as from 13th December 2023, will require all producers selling livestock for slaughter to have had an annual farm veterinary visit to allow their animals, and/or part of any animal, to be exported out of the UK. The purpose of the new rule is to comply with EU export requirements to verify the absence of notifiable disease and provide general advice on farm biosecurity.

Why is this changing?

The Statutory Health Attestation is required from the 13 December 2023 to certify exports of POAO (Products of Animal Origin) to the EU. The EHCs (Export Health Certificates) require that the animals' farm of origin has undergone regular visits by a veterinary surgeon.

What do producers need to do?

Producers will be required to obtain a signed declaration from their vet that the visit has taken place. The veterinary attestation template can be found here: <u>veterinary attestation template</u>. This should be signed and completed by the farm vet.

Obtaining a signed veterinary attestation must be done at least once over a 12month period and can be combined with any other routine veterinary visit, including government supported initiatives such as the Animal Health and Welfare Pathway in England.

Farmers and vets must keep a copy of their completed declarations and the "unique reference number" created, for their records and to provide to their livestock auction market or meat processor.

Farms that are part of qualifying assurance schemes do not need to complete the veterinary declaration. Membership of these farm assurance schemes is accepted as evidence that a premises of origin meets the requirement for regular health visits from a vet.

The qualifying schemes are:

- Annual health and welfare review (England only)
- Quality Meat Scotland (QMS)
- Farm Assured Welsh Livestock Beef and Lamb Scheme (FAWL) (Welsh Lamb and Beef Producers Ltd (WLBP))
- Red Tractor

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 25TH NOVEMBER

Store & Breeding Cattle

Prices sold to £1700 for a pair of Limousin steers from AJ Day & Son, their other Limousin steers sold to £1510, £1460 from £1380; Doraville Farms 32 month Blue steers sold to £910, 27 month Hereford steers to £910 and 31 month Beef Shorthorn steers to £835; M Holben sold his Continental heifers to £1070 and £1010 from £800; TEW Farming sold 8 month Angus steers to £750 and heifers to £600; R Munns sold a Simmental steer to £1260 and a Saler steer to £1200; R Martin sold a 6 month Hereford steer to £670 and two 15 month Limousin steers to £560; M & M Hutton sold a 29 month Limousin steer to £1310, a 17 month Angus steer to £950 and an 18 month Limousin steer to £980.

PR Rogers sold a Red Poll cow that had run with the bull at £780 and an Angus cow which sold to £555; NP & MJ Russell sold a 10 year old empty cow which sold to £700

Calves

A new vendor this week, Cholmondeley Farms who entered fifteen 4-6 week old calves selling to £105 for Simmental bulls and a heifer to £90, Angus bulls and heifers sold to £60 taking an overall average to £52.67. AG Burton sold Aberdeen Angus bulls to £155, heifers to £90 and Holstein bulls to £55 from £45.

281 Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - trade remains at similar levels, hopper lambs look a tremendous trade with longer term types easing on the week. Averaging £79.61. Reynolds Farmers Ltd topped the day with big framed Suffolk lambs to £107.50, £100 and £98; JH Jones & Son topped with a well grown run of Charollais Mules to £97 with followers at £91, £91 and £88; NP & MJ Russell saw some of the best trade with Beltex crosses at £92; H Houghton & Son saw their Texel crosses in forward condition selling to £88.50. Mid frame leaner types were in the £70's with longer term smaller frames in the £60's. Native bred lambs were hardest sold on the day.

Feeding Ewes - a strong trade for meat with healthy sorts at the same level as recent weeks, averaging £68.85. Webb Hatherley Livestock topped with Continental ewes to £87.50 and Mules to £85.50, with followers at £78. True feeders and native breeds were around £50.




