A smart penning of lambs forward this week, heavier lambs in demand. SQQ 308.77p/kg. B Burrows topped the day with Continental cross Charollais at 316.5p/kg with A & KM Byrd selling to £145.53 for lambs in the lump.

45 Standards 32.1-39kg - TO Withers topped the lightest lambs of the day with a sterling show of class, seeing their Texels to 307p/kg at 38.5kgs with Charollais just behind at 306p/kg for 39kgs; RJ Haynes topped the Suffolks for this section with 38.5kg lambs also selling to 306p/kg.
