Trade has eased on the week with a bigger showing nationally and a drop in demand. Quality is still sought after and meat is crucial. SQQ 318.18p/kg. K Buckby topped at 363p/kg for Blue Texels with A&H Hunt topping overall at £200.

Highlights - CJ Whitehead & Son topped with smart Texel lambs at 44.5kgs to £154 with followers at 45.5kgs to £148. SR Tunnicliffe saw a best end show of Texel with meat seeing 45 & 45.5kgs to £148.50. K Buckby topped at £189 for Blue Texels at 52kgs with 46kgs to £157. J Bland saw their Texel at 50kgs to £171. R&M Arrowsmith saw their best end Texels at £160 for 49kgs. A&H Hunt topped overall with a big showing of meat Dutch spotted at 73kgs selling to £200 with followers to £197 for 67kgs.

Store & Breeding Cattle - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

J Handy saw a smart trade for cows and calves with Blue cross cows at 3 years old with 5 month Hereford bull calves to £1450, older Charollais with Hereford heifers sold to £1360.

Big framed short term lambs sold £105 plus with mid term £83 to £95. Longest term lambs were £50 to £65. Ram lambs were £15 back on like for like.
