REPORT FOR THURSDAY 8TH SEPTEMBER

364 Prime Lambs

Trades holds up on the week, with a lesser showing of meat forward. Demand for best end lambs trumped all, with the highs far outreaching last week's best. Weight is still key but lighter smart export lambs are seeing their own tier of trade. SQQ 235.34p/kg. Penny & Annie Bonner topped all aspects of the market this week with thumping Texel lambs, their best saw 45kgs sell to 293p/kg and 60.5kgs top at £144.

Highlights – Raveley Fen Farms saw their best end Charollais cross lambs fly, with 57.5kgs selling to £138, 54kgs at £130 and 50.5kgs at £137; Rook Bros Farms topped with their Texel crosses to £125; K Holman penned a smart showing of 49kgs Suffolk crosses selling to £123; C Stancombe & Son saw another flying trade with their Texel cross lambs at 51kgs reaching £120; Giles Green saw a smart trade with best finished Texel crosses at 43kgs top at £112; CN Sansom topped their run of Texels to £109 for 43.5kgs; Lloyd & Walton drew a well fleshed run of Texel crosses to £108.50 for 45kgs.

MK Jones topped the day with a class showing of Charollais cross ewes selling to £138; JE Cox & Sons followed close behind with Suffolks reaching £136 and Texels to £132; KS Lee saw similar with their best end Suffolk ewes reaching £130; H Elsdon topped the rams for the day with Hampshires at £128.50; J & K Holmes penned the usual goods with thumping Texels topping at £126 over several pens; Raveley Fen Farms topped the Mules for the day with ewes reaching £119. Lean meat ewes comparatively look best sold compared to the fat. Feeding ewes are selling to limited accounts with a top end cap of £25.

On the whole a far stronger showing of lambs forward this week. More active accounts pen side this week, with all grades of lambs sought after. All in average £68.05. L Dexter topped the day with Texel lambs in forward condition selling to £95; Reynolds Farmers Ltd penned a smart showing of big framed Suffolk Mule lambs, the top end saw £94; AJ Cony & Partners saw a strong showing of Charollais Suffolk crosses selling at £90.50, with the same vendor realising £81 for a run of ram lambs; N Lee topped their run with Continentals reaching £86; NP & MJ Russell drew a run of Texel Mule lambs, the biggest frames sold to £85 with followers at £79; CD Hughes drew a tidy run of Continental x Mules with the shortest term lambs to £83. A vast run of Continental crosses could be bought in the late £70's with longest term lambs looking dearer on the week, at £60 plus.

Feeding Ewes - all grades sold well with feeding ewes seeing the best trade, strong ewes in the most forward condition struggled for active buyers in the feeding ewe section. Prices ranged from £9 to £100 with an all in average of £57.23. N Lee topped the ewes with their leaner Charollais flying to £100 with fatter ewes at £89; R Booth topped the Suffolks at £90 over several lots; JI Spendlove saw a strong trade for Charollais feeders with pens selling to £89; FE Harris & Sons topped their Suffolks with ewes to £87.
