Highlights - P Stiles topped their Charollais Mules with best finished lambs at 45.5kgs selling to £164; R Swinfen & Sons penned their usual stamp of Texels seeing meated 45.5kgs to £163; F & SM Stamper saw their Texel and Charollais at the top with 50kg to 380p/kg; SGC Hill penned a real run of quality with Suffolk crosses best finished topping the day at £194.50 for 56kgs with 53kgs to £192.

S Handy topped the day with best end Texel ewes to £227 for both meat and shape; WF Knight & Son saw a brilliant uniform run of Continental ewes forward with highs of £215 for the best shape, following onto £198, £195, £194, £186, £180, £177 and £168; R Swinfen & Sons topped their ewes to £199 for Continental crosses; CP Hankins & Son saw Texels to £197, also topping the Mules at £147; The Warriner School saw Boer Nannie's to £170; Proctor Bros topped with their biggest meat Lleyn and Romney crosses selling to £170 with followers at £138. All meat sold at £130 plus with lighter framed lean meat ewes £108 to £125. Grazing sorts sold £70 to £93. Fat is harder sold than meat and did draw down comparable ewes in size.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 26TH JULY

Pigs - Auctioneer Richard Spendlove

Just the one pig today, an aged Saddleback boar sold to £10 from S Wisson.

Calves - Auctioneer Richard Spendlove

A nice show of calves met a packed ringside keen to buy. Newlands Farm presented their usual quality Charolais with the bull making £560 and the heifer just behind at £550, just 21 days old; FH Pullin & Sons Ltd presented reared and rearing calves, topping at £460 for reared named sire Aberdeen Angus with others £390 from £250, their Holstein steers topped at £395 with others at £300 to £350 with buyers taking advantage of all the rearing work having being done. Holstein bucket calves sold to £190 from £80 with an Ayrshire to £110. More sought to meet buyers demand.

380 Store & Breeding Sheep - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

Store Lambs - best end trade with a good show of Continental quality throughout., averaging £99.65. C Smith topped the day with Texel ewe lambs selling to £140 and £129; AJ Geary topped their run of Texel crosses seeing well grown lambs to £125 with followers at £119 and £106.50; RC Howes saw another run this week with Continental crosses to £125, £118.50, £118; J Handy saw similar highs with £120.50 for big framed part meat. All big framed well bred, hopper type lambs sold for £105 plus, smart healthy true stores needing growth sold at £90 plus. Native bred sorts saw JL Hammond and Blackie wethers sell to £90.50, Grey Faced Dartmoor crosses sold at £85 and £60, Soay lambs sold to £39.50 and £30.

Feeding Ewes - another flying trade this week averaging £110.88. CG Holt topped the day with a Blue Texel ram at £188 with their Mule feeders selling to £102; S Gawthroup topped their Continentals with rams to £163.50 with meat cross breds around £150; D Morgan saw a run of 2-tooth Continental crosses selling between £135 and £140; G Exton topped their Suffolks with lean meat at £107; LA Burton topped their Texel Lleyn ewes to £128; S Yates saw their Jacobs to £98. True feeders were all seen high £80's to £95. Herdwicks were at £50.

Store & Breeding Cattle - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

A lift in numbers bolstered the crowd and trade. RD Holland started the day with a smart show of Limousins seeing their 12 month steers sell to £1220 and heifers of the same stamp to £1150; S & R Wright jumped to older Angus Charollais with their well grown steers at £1915 for 20 months and the same price for their heifers; FH Pullin & Sons Ltd drew a run of Angus, their steers at 17 months topped to £1300 with 12 months on the same potential to £1075, heifers at 17 months topped overall at £1360. A run of stirks from the same home saw their Angus at £845 for 9 months and 5 months to £680, Friesians at 5 months topped at £530 with 4 months at £530, £415 and 3 months to £320; The Rectory Rangers saw their first draw of Dexter cattle through the market with 27 month bulls selling to £700, steers to £570 and heifers at £480; Heritage Farm Partnership also saw their first sale of stores with us seeing Hereford steers at 14 months sell to £1525 and heifers at the same stamp to £1320, Dairy cross Herefords at the same age saw £810.

Sale of Pedigree Southdowns

The Third Annual Unofficial Sale of Pedigree Southdowns saw an increased entry as the sale gains momentum with 60 sheep forward.

The trade of the day was seen in the *Rams* with a lengthy shearling from the Sutherland flock making 450guineas; A 1st prized shearling ram from the Glandore flock made 370gns; the East Dean flock presented a nice run of rams topping at 350 from 280gns; the Webb –Ellis flock saw their rams to 260 from 200gns. Aged rams sold from 50 to 90gns. Only 2 MV Accredited shearling rams on offer from the Mymswood flock selling to 200gns from £150gns.

Limited trade for *Ram Lambs*, potentially requiring a little more time to look their best with the Webb–Ellis flock taking the top spot at 120gns, from 70gns for a little ram from the Rudham flock.

Aged Ewes from the Heritage flock set the trade to 200gns for a six year old ewe from 180gns; with the Webb-Ellis flock to 155gns from 140gns; New vendor, Foxley Spring flock saw 180gns for her three year old ewe; the Glatton flock achieved 150gns. **Shearling Ewes** were more sought after with the Champion of the day from the Glandore flock seeing the judge back her decision taking it home at 300gns with others from the same flock to 180gns; Foxley Spring flock sold her shearling for 150gns; with the Rudham flock selling to 100gns twice.




