585 Prime Hoggs

Trade looks here to stay with another strong week of prices. Heavier hoggs look slightly easier on the week but mid weights took another lift. SQQ 317.48p/kg. AJ Geary topped the day pence per kilo at 375p/kg with SJ Leedham topping overall at \pm 180.

Highlights - AJ Geary topped with lighter Beltex hoggs at 40.5kgs selling to £152 with 36.5kg to £134, their Cheviot crosses saw similar highs with 42kgs to £144.50; Park End Farming saw their usual stamp of Texels forward with 44.5kgs to £155 and 47kgs to £163.50 for strong meat; BW Costin & Sons penned a run of Charollais Texels seeing a top of £145.50 for 43kgs; Pentelow Farms penned best fed Continental hoggs at 51kgs selling to £169.50 and 50kgs to £166; C Stancombe & Son saw their Texel Mules at a flying trade with meat to £162 for 52kgs; SJ Leedham topped the day at £180 for 63kg Charollais crosses; R & M Arrowsmith continue their hopper fed hoggs at £177 for 59kg Suffolks; CW Webb & Partners saw a strong framed run of Suffolks and Charollais selling to £175 for 57.5kgs.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 11TH JANUARY

Store & Breeding Cattle

An empty Limousin cow from W Darby & Son sold to £1850. **Store Cattle** sold to £2150 and £2120 for Simmental steers from NP & MJ Russell; W Darby & Son sold Limousin steers to £1870 and £1580; R Booth sold a Holstein steer to £800; D Player sold Angus steers to £1140, £1130 from £950 and 7 month Beef Shorthorn steers to £1010 and a heifer to £985; R Munns sold Angus steers to £1540 from £1470 and a Limousin heifer to £1040.

Calves

A good number of calves forward today which sold to £375 for British Blue bulls from Sunbeam Farms and their heifers sold to £295; J E G James sold their British Blue bulls and heifers to £370 and Angus bulls to £280; PS Hemmings sold Charolais heifers to £310, Charolais bulls to £300, Limousin heifers to £250 and Limousin bulls to £220.

Pigs

Only small weaned pigs forward today (the larger ones booked in this week). T Bateley sold weaned pigs to £40 from £20, sows to £50 from £40; and T Drury sold a White gilt to £80.

360 Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - trade kicks up another gear with an all in average of £113.98. Serious prices throughout with trade looking at least £20 dearer like for like on the week. Mill Farm topped with short term Texel lambs at £140.50 with followers to £126; WG Childs & Sons saw their usual stamp of big framed Charollais and Texel lambs to £139.50, £138.50 and £129 twice; MP Beesley & Son topped with Continentals to £136; Corney & Sons topped the ram lambs with Charollais at £132; I Sargent saw a smart trade for Mule crosses at £126.50; L Lane saw the trade of the day with indoor Suffolk lambs to £123.50. Any mid frame lambs were £115 plus, with long term lambs £94 to £110. Very chancy longest term sold from £30 to £73.
