361 Prime Lambs - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

National shortage of meat and numbers force a jump in the trade. An absolute flyer this week with the SQQ jumping to 329.12p/kg. Hadley Farms topped at 372p/kg with WF Knight & Son topping overall at £187.

Highlights - Hadley Farms saw 372p/kg or £145 for 39kg Berrichon crosses full of meat, with KS Lee close behind at £130 for Charollais Suffolks at 39kgs and 63kgs to £178. WF Knight & Son saw their usual stamp of Continental lambs forward with 44kgs selling to £156 and 42kgs to £151, with their heavier 46.5kgs to £164 and topping the day at £187 for 60kgs. JR Smith & Son topped their Texel lambs to £170 for 55kgs with 48.5kgs to £162. WH & IM Butcher saw their Continentals at 45kgs to £154 with Suffolks at 53kgs to £167.

Store Lambs - Another absolute flyer with a few less numbers due to the weather made up with surprise entries. All in average £117.27. MJ Lovett topped the day at £136.50 for Texel crosses. GC Snowden started the day with a flying trade at £128 for mid frame Texel crosses. All mid frame lambs sold £120 plus with long termers £110 to £118. Chanciest sorts sold in the £90s.

Feeding Ewes - following the lamb trade a flyer averaging £124.29. KC Robins topped at £185.50 for Texel crosses with meat, all meat sold above £146 lean meat feeding sorts were £125. Leanest mules sold at £106.

Goats - Auctioneer Richard Spendlove

A dispersal sale of Pygmy Goats on behalf of TH Trembath saw in kid yearling nannies to £170 with older in kidders to £130. Nanny kids to £95 with wethers to £42 from £32. The stock billy sold for £110.

Calves - Auctioneer Richard Spendlove

A small entry from Messrs JEG James (TB1) saw their British Blue bulls top at £550 from £540, Blue heifers £410 from £390. Aberdeen Angus heifers to £305 from £275.
