Highlights - F & SM Stamper topped with Beltex lambs at 41.5kgs selling to 329p/kg or £136.50. A Hodson saw a smart trade for meat Blue Texels at 43kgs selling to £138.50. J Gowling & Sons saw their usual stamp of Texels forward with 52kgs selling to £159. SC Wells topped the day with Texels at £169 for 55kgs of best meat and shape.

578 Store Sheep - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

Breeders - Conington Farms saw their Suffolk Mule Theaves ran with the ram since the 8/10 top to £180 with their Texel 2 shear ram selling at £310. DLJ Hughes topped their Texel shearling rams to £490 with followers at £420. GL Gent & Son saw a best end showing of Suffolk shearlings forward with highs of £460 for 2 and £390.

Store lambs - A flying trade this week they keep getting dearer averaging £115.06. E Sansom & Son topped the day at £149 for best bred short term Texels, with followers at £134.50, £129 and £126.50. WG Childs & Son saw their first draw of Texels and Charollais lambs for the season with highs of £143.50, £139, £130. CP Hankins & Son saw their Charollais ram lambs top at £132, £126, £125 and £124. LA Burton saw their usual stamp of Texel Lleyns forward selling to £127.50 and £124. All mid term lambs sold over £109 with long term lambs dearer on the day at £89 to £105. More needed to meet demand!

Feeding Ewes - another step up on the week averaging £100.48. JR Fisher topped at £167 for Texel crosses. R King saw the best of the Mule trade at £139. All meat sold above £130, leanest meat sold at £105 to £117. Longest term chancy ewes £64 to £80.

Cows & Calves - WBK Smith & Son saw their 4 year old Simmental cow with a 7 month Simmental bull at foot sell to £2420. Limousin first calvers at 3 years with 5 month Limousin bull calves at foot sold at £2020 an outfit for both.

Barren Cows - J Millbank saw a smart trade for young barren Simmental cows at 40 months with potential seeing £1580 and £1520. M Keeble saw similar highs with Longhorns at 12 years selling to £1490.

Store Cattle - CJ Grange Started the day with the younger cattle seeing TB4 Hereford steers at 9 months sell to £1020 with the same heifers to £870. T Prowse saw their usual stamp of best end TB4 Limousins forward at 11 months with steers to £1680 and heifers to £1490. NE Pullin saw best end suckler bred Angus through the ring at 8 months with steers to £960 and bulls to £820, their heifers flew at £950 with the youngest at 2 months reaching £440. M Keeble saw their Longhorn

bulls top to £840 at 10 months with heifers to £700. SGC Hill saw the trade of the day with another best end run of Charollais x Saler steers forward at 7 months selling to £1500 and £1410.

Northen & Son saw their heifers forward this week on the same stamp as their steers the week before. Top of the day saw their Blondes to £2620 with followers at £2290, £2240 and 4 more lots over £2000 all at 18 months, the Saler crosses from the same home topped to £2160. AJ Geary saw their Angus steers at 18 months to £1840. DP & JM Osbourne saw their Angus steers to £1760 at 16 months. J Howkins & Son penned a top class showing of big framed cattle in forward condition seeing highs of £2750 for 31 month Limousin steers, with a pen of 4 Limousin steers at 30 months to £2300, all of their cattle sold above £1780. LC Threadgold & Son drew a quality run of Angus steers and heifers in forward condition seeing highs of £1760 for 12 month steers and heifers to £1320. LH Harvey topped their Simmental heifers at 29months to £1800. DA Brown saw a smart show of south Devon steers and heifers forward with the steers topping to £1580 and heifers to £1760.

An entry of Mangalica x pigs from T Bird saw them top at £18 for gilts and £5 for a small Black Boar.


