All ranges covered in the cows with CG Holt showing thick framed Aberdeen Angus selling to £1470. RA Willmott showed a stylish Limousin cow selling to £1055.

PA Wilford had a smart showing of Hereford crosses at 24 months selling to \pounds 1305 for the best with followers at \pounds 1160. Corney & Sons drew the usual class with smart Limousin steers at 14 months old selling to \pounds 1030. S&R Wright topped with thick Aberdeen Angus steers at 24 months to \pounds 1300.

Store Sheep

Store lambs continue at tremendous levels compared to the prime market, all in average at \pounds 74.31. M&M Hutton topped the day with Continentals selling to \pounds 116.
