491 Prime Hoggs - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

Trade eases overall with up to 48kgs in stronger demand, heavies saw a stickier trade with limited outlets and over supply nationwide. Smart shape continues in a stream of its own. SQQ 322.51p/kg. Overall average 305.49p/kg. F & S M Stamper topped at 373p/kg with Marshall Farms topping overall at £190.

Highlights - Guilford & Sons saw their 36kg Texel crosses to £130 for smart meat. F & S M Stamper topped with Beltex at 42.5kgs to 373p/kg or £158.50, followed by 41kgs to £152. G Green continues their best end run of Continentals seeing 45.5kgs to £158 with 49kgs to £159. Corney & Sons saw a smart show of Charollais forward with 45kgs to £157. A M Rouse penned a top end showing of Rouge x Texel at 50kgs selling to £167. H B Farming saw a best meat run of Texel lambs 52kgs to £175 and 48kgs to £168. Scott & Scott penned their usual stamp of best meat Texel crosses with 62kgs to £165 and 58kgs to £159. Marshall Farms topped the day overall with a tremendous Suffolk lamb at 90kgs selling to £190.

A stand on trade for the week averaging £140.11 with similar highs on a classy entry of ewes. R Swinfen & Sons topped the day with Texels to £273, which followed at £264 x 2 and £250. A G Murdoch & Sons saw comparable highs with Continental cross ewes at £230 with big framed meat mule cross ewes to £181. H B Farming saw highs of £189 for shapely mid frame texel ewes. All shape Continental ewes sold above £167, with leaner smaller frame meat still £140 to £156. Leaner meat Lleyne ewes sold to £137 averaging around £125. True feeders sold £75 to £105 frame depending.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 17TH JANUARY

Store and Breeding Cattle - Auctioneer Jake Wagstaff

Feeding Cows - C P Hankins saw flyer with 33 month Hereford cows of mid frame farm assured selling to £2060. Angus cows at 82 months sold to £1440 of mid frame and older Herefords to £920

Breeding Cows - E G Dodson & Son saw another genuine production sale of TB4 cows with calves at foot, they had been out wintered and in work good condition with 1-3month reg sire Angus steers calves at foot. The Blue cross cows topped to £2700 for the outfit with followers at £2500 and £2400. J Towers took top prize for the day with a strong Angus cow at 10 years old back in calf by 3 months and with a Shorthorn heifer calf at 4 months at foot selling to £3000.

Store Cattle - a flying trade that no report can show. Come to market and see for yourselves. C P Hankins kicked the day off with 9 month Hereford steers selling to £900 with Hereford heifers to £800 at 7 months. 3-4 month Angus stirks sold to £350 plus with Holstein Friesian steers at 7 months reaching £500. L A Burton saw their usual stamp of Limousins forward with heifers at 8 months selling to £1200. J Towers saw a smart run of Shorthorn x Angus heifers forward at 12 months selling to £1320. D Player saw a fantastic run of suckled calves forward with Limousin steers at 9 months topping to £1870 with Angus steers at 10 months to £1770. The following Limousin steers at 9 months sold to £1450, £1410 and £1309. T E W Farming penned their Angus cross Continentals with tremendous 10 month calves in forward condition selling to £1940 for the top with followers at £1760, £1620 and £1470. Heifers at the same age sold to £1400.

R Munns saw the start of the stronger age cattle with 21 month Hereford steers to £1800. P G Duffin & Son saw their usual goods of Charolais heifers forward at 20 months with highs of £1560. A pair of Blue heifers from the same home at 17 months sold to £990 with Hereford cross Friesian heifers to £950.

Calves - Auctioneer Richard Spendlove

Messrs J E G James presented their usual quality with their British Blue Bull calf leading the way at £565 with other £555, £550, £520 from £480, a lovely long British Blue heifer took the top place for the heifers at £500. Aberdeen Angus from the same home saw Bulls to £410 and heifers £380. A G Burton sold Hereford Bulls and heifers to £370 from £300, Welsh Black heifers to £290 from £240. Their Holstein Friesian Bulls had the trade of the day topping at £200 from £160.

382 Store Sheep

Store lambs - stand on trade for the week averaging £112.30. Small frame smart shape longer term potential lambs continue to look the best sold. D Burton topped the day at £130 for smart Texel cross lambs, with followers to £125 and £118. J Grace topped their run at £129.50 for Texel crosses. R Truss topped the Suffolks at £123.50. All healthy mid frame lambs sold above £116. Small smart lambs no matter how long term sold above £107. Longest term chancy sorts were £94 plus.

Feeding Ewes - a smaller show forward averaging £119.67. O Asplen topped the day at £158 for Texel crosses. H Elsdon saw similar highs for Hampshire ewes at £143.50. Lean meat was £125 with feeding sorts around £100.

Breeding Ewes - Mowsley Hills Farm saw a smart entry of Lleyne theaves forward unscanned but ran with the Lleyne ram and sold to £180 and £170. H Elsdon saw a show of flock age unscanned ewes forward with Texel crosses to £192 and Hampshires to £186 with younger Suffolk ewes to £186.

ROAD CLOSURES - A14 River Nene Bridge, near Thrapston
