REPORT FOR TUESDAY 28TH SEPTEMBER

230 Prime Lambs

Best meat lambs sold to premiums with a national shortage for best quality now driving the trade. Highs were seen from W Bartlett & Son with lambs to 230p/kg alongside D Stroud also at 230p/kg. Baylis Farming topped in the lump with heavier lambs reaching £104. On the day with all lambs in, the SQQ saw 217.5p/kg.

47 Standards

W Bartlett & Son topped with a sterling showing of Beltex lambs at 230p/kg for 34kgs. BS & FL Pile were close behind with smart finished Texel lambs at 37.5kgs coming to 228p/kg. Cotswold Stud & Farms penned a smart run of Charollais with the lightest weights seeing 225.5p/kg for Charollais at 38.5kgs. TO Withers saw the same trade with their Charollais at 38kgs coming to 225p/kg.

A two tier trade seen on the day with long term lambs looking best sold. A full spectrum of lambs forward from £19 to £80 leading to an average of £66.13. Best bred lambs drew the best trade with B Burrows & Sons topping at £80 for Charollais cross lambs, with a second pen close behind at £77.50. AR & PR Whitmill matched with another top run of Suffolk lambs reaching £77.50. SL Hitchman topped their run at £76 with smart Texel lambs. Long term lambs consistently hit the £60 mark with many reaching mid to high 60's.

Plants & Shrubs, Produce, Hatching Eggs, Fur & Feather, Sundries

There was another good offering in all sections and a good company of buyers.

Starting with the plants, a collection of planted baskets made £14; Hydrangeas sold to £13 with smaller ones up to £8; and garden seats made £24.

In the produce section, trays of cooking apples made £6; pears £12.50; and tomatoes £3.25; and there was a good selection of fresh vegetables; carrots, beetroot, beans, peas, cucumbers, sweetcorn etc. from 50p per lot to £1.75.

In the egg section, 1 dozen Duck eggs £2; trays of eggs £3, Quail eggs to £2.25 per dozen for the best, from 80p.

A very mixed lot of poultry saw geese to £20; Columbian Black Pullets £8; Guinea Fowl £4; Call Ducks £12; Doc Rabbits £10.

The miscellaneous items ranged from £1 to £50. Top price was for a set of Lister clippers. We sold several saddles from £18 to £41; a pair of drive lamps £30; a security box £24; Wolf gardening tools £30; pet cages £16; Croquet set £14; and poultry crates to £10.


