NO WARRANTY AS TO WEIGHT, QUALITY OR CONDITION CAN BE GIVEN, ANY INTENDING PURCHASER SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE INSPECTED THE LOT IN WHICH HE IS INTERESTED. FOR INSPECTION OF ALL LOTS PLEASE CONTACT THE RELEVANT TELEPHONE NUMBERS PROVIDED.**
4. All lots must be paid for in full in the Market Office at the termination of the sale.
5. **CHEQUES WILL BE ACCEPTED IN PAYMENT ONLY IF A SATISFACTORY REFERENCE IS GIVEN TO THE AUCTIONEERS BEFORE THE START OF THE SALE.**
